## **Mechanic**

The Town of La Ronge is seeking a full-time permanent mechanic who will be responsible for inspecting, maintaining, servicing and repairing all Town motorized and non-motorized equipment and vehicles and ensuring such items are in good working order and in safe operating condition in compliance with all applicable laws, policies and regulations; ordering parts and maintaining inventory; and preparing detailed records of all servicing, repairs and safety inspections, including reporting mechanical conditions and/or deficiencies to the Manager of Public Works. This position may also require the operation of heavy-duty equipment from time to time.

Qualifications for the position include: high school diploma or GED; a valid class 5 Saskatchewan driver's license; standard first aid and CPR certification; WHMIS; and physically aptitude and ability to lift up to 50lbs. Experience with heavy equipment and/or air brake endorsement is considered an asset. Preference may be given to candidates with a journeyman automotive technician certification, and/or a minimum of 3 years experience. This position requires work in various weather conditions. The successful mechanic will be required to provide their own tools.

Please note that the Town of La Ronge practices global reference checks, and the successful candidate must submit to an acceptable criminal record check. The Town of La Ronge offers a comprehensive benefit package, pension, and annual tool and boot allowance. The position may be eligible for relocation assistance. The 2025 hourly wage range for this position is \$26.27 to \$40.96 per hour, which is dependent upon qualifications and experience. Candidates completing an automotive apprenticeship, or possessing a journeyman heavy duty mechanic certification are encouraged to apply, and will be paid in accordance with their certification.
